You will be walked through the format of BBQ competitions, you will learn what characteristics to look for in each categories' entries, you will learn how to score an entry, you learn the rules and regulations that BBQ competitions have, and you will be run through a mock BBQ Competition that includes Chicken, Ribs, Pork Shoulder, and Brisket sample entries. This experience will help you be a good BBQ Judge.
